SPECIAL MEASURES TO ASSIST IN HALTING THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS

In addition to introducing the steps below, set out by Bishop Toal to try to prevent the spread of the virus, we have made **additional arrangements** in relation to Offertory Collections and Votive candles.

- The Holy Water stoops for blessing ourselves to be emptied. We can still bless ourselves as we enter the Church but without using Holy Water;
- The Sign of Peace will be suspended for the time being;
- We receive Holy Communion in the hand rather than on the tongue;
- The Lay Faithful will not receive the Precious Blood while the present crisis lasts.
- All Ministers of the Eucharist must wash or sanitise their hands before distributing communion
- Only the Priest Celebrant or Assisting Deacon should purify the Sacred Vessels used at Mass.
- Sacristan, and others with responsibility in setting up for Mass, must wash their hands thoroughly before touching the Sacred vessels and the hosts to be consecrated at Mass.
- New plastic collection baskets will now be used at all Masses Passkeepers will use antibacterial cleaners on the baskets after each Mass.
- Votive candles- the gas lighters will also be cleaned by the Passkeepers after each Mass.
