EMBRACING THE FUTURE

Bishop Toal's announcement that Fr Bernard is our new Parish Priest and that Fr Pat is remaining in ministry in the parish, with Fr Stephen in residence, gives us hope that the parish is well placed to make all the arrangements necessary for the church to reopen safely when we are able to do so. Please keep all the clergy, including Deacon Bill, in your prayers.

WHEN WILL THE CHURCH RE-OPEN?

For now, all churches will remain closed. When we enter *Phase 2*, we will be able to open for private prayer and *Phase 3* will allow for some church services to resume with limited numbers able to attend. *Phase 4* - likely to be some months away yet - should see a return to 'unrestricted' church services.

In the next week, our Bishops are expected to issue some guidance to parishes about the health and safety measures which we must put in place before we will be allowed to re-open. There will also be advice about how we can re-build our parish activities, supporting those in greatest need at these difficult times. Small, careful steps will be taken to ensure that these activities are all assessed so that they are safe to resume. We may need to change some of our normal activities, in the light of safety concerns. Planning is already underway in the parish to ensure that we will be prepared.

WHAT CHANGES WILL WE SEE IN CHURCH?

We will be required to change our opening times, to limit numbers entering the building, to use one-way entry & exit routes. We shall provide clear advice on how to prepare for coming to church and how to keep safe when you are here.

CAN WE FIND ENOUGH VOLUNTEERS TO RE-OPEN?

We are grateful to those who have volunteered to help with the sanitisation of the church and to direct people in and out of the church. But we will need more volunteers before we are allowed to reopen. NB. We respectfully ask that no one who is in any 'vulnerable' group should offer to be a volunteer.
