KEY POINTS FOR YOU TO CONSIDER

- Please observe 2 metre distancing spaces on the floor and the pews.
- You will be directed to a particular seat. Please follow directions.
- On entering and exiting you must avoid crossing over other people.
- You must exit by the side doors.
- The church will be sanitised each day.
