



## SACRED HEART OF JESUS DEVOTION

In the Catholic Church, the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in veneration and in gratitude for His merciful heart and His redeeming love for mankind. Many saints have furthered their love and devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus but none have been as instrumental as St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun, who experienced visions of Jesus beginning in 1673, when Jesus asked her to have a special feast established in honour of His Sacred Heart. The visions revealed to her the form of the devotion, mainly reception of Holy Communion on the first Friday of each month, Eucharistic adoration during a "Holy hour" on Thursdays, and the celebration of the Feast of the Sacred Heart. She stated that in her vision she was instructed to spend an hour every Thursday night to meditate on Jesus' Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane.



Jesus made 12 promises to St Margaret Mary to those who were devoted to his Sacred Heart:-

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state in life.
- 2. I will establish peace in their families.
- 3. I will comfort them in their trials.
- 4. I will be their secure refuge during life, and, above all, in death.
- 5. I will shed abundant blessings on all their undertakings
- 6. Sinners will find in My Heart an infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Lukewarm souls will become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls will rapidly grow in holiness and perfection.
- 9. I will bless every place where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honoured.
- 10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11. The names of those who promote this devotion will be written in My Heart, never to be blotted out.
- 12. I promise thee, in the excessive mercy of My Heart, that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months, the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is a solemnity and is celebrated the third Friday after Pentecost, it was celebrated this year on Friday (11<sup>th</sup> June).

"And He [Christ] showed me that it was His great desire of being loved by men and of withdrawing them from the path of ruin that made Him want to manifest His Heart to men, with all the treasures of love, of mercy, of grace, of sanctification and salvation which it contains, in order that those who desire to render Him and procure Him all the honour and love possible might themselves be abundantly enriched with those divine treasures of which His heart is the source."
