Our parish mission is finally here! We look forward to welcoming you over the course of the week, in particular those who have been away for the church, for whatever reason. We pray that this will be a time of grace and renewal for our parish as we reflect on the 80th anniversary of our church building. Many generations have worshipped here, for some of us these will include family members. We thank them for their faith and their sacrifices which helped build this church and in so doing helped to enrich our parish.

We extend a very warm welcome to Fr Pius Collins and Fr Stephen Morrison who are joining us from London for the week, to lead us in our mission. Fr Pius and Fr Stephen are Norbertine priests, a Roman Catholic religious order founded in 1120 by St. Norbert of Xanten, who coincidentally was a friend of St Bernard!

Fr Pius was born in Nottingham and studied theology in Oxford, London, and Rome, and canon law at KU Leuven (Belgium). He joined the Norbertine Order in the Canonry of Our Lady of Sorrows and St Philip Benizi, Chelmsford, in 2011, and was ordained to the Sacred Priesthood in 2016. He is currently Vice-Chancellor of the Diocese of Brentwood, Chaplain of Anglia Ruskin University (Chelmsford Campus), and Editor of the Canon Law Society of Great Britain and Ireland's Newsletter. He enjoys cooking, eating, and reading about American history.



Rev. Stephen Morrison o.praem.

Born into a long line of Glasgow Morrisons (his father converted from the Kirk to the Catholic Faith shortly after marriage), Fr Stephen was born in Rugby and raised in Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire. Having studied French at Oxford, Fr Stephen joined the Norbertine Order in 2009, was solemnly professed in 2012 and ordained a priest in 2014. He serves as Sub-Prior, Novice Master and Cantor. He is assistant priest in the two parishes run by the Canonry in Chelmsford, is chaplain to the local Primary School, and is a chaplain of the Order of Malta. His interests are the Sacred Liturgy, music and foreign languages - he is fluent in French, Spanish, and Italian. He looks forward to returning to St Columbkille's!
