

#### SYNOD 2021-2023

As you are probably aware the church is currently undergoing a Synod, called by Pope Francis to discuss the theme:- For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission.

What makes this Synod unique is the invitation from Pope Francis for the whole People of God to participate. He has asked that every diocese set up a process through which all the baptised can meet in prayer, listening, and discernment to hear what the Holy Spirit is saying to the Church at this moment in history.


This process began in Motherwell Diocese on 17<sup>th</sup> October when Bishop Toal opened the Synod. Our parish representatives attended a training session about the synodal process in November and are now in the process of organising a series of meetings (four in total) which will take place in the parish during Lent. These meetings are open to all parishioners and we would encourage you to attend. We extend a particular invitation to our young people ~ after all you are the future of the church!

More details will follow regarding the meetings; in the meantime there are some leaflets at the back of the church about the synodal process.
