ASH WEDNESDAY

The holy season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday this week. It is a day of fasting and abstinence. **Fasting** is required of adult Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. You are permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence (refraining from the consumption of meat) is obliged for Catholics 14 and older.

Holy Mass and the distribution of ashes will be at 7am, 10am, 1pm and 7pm. We are delighted that the children from St Columbkille's Primary will be joining us for Mass at 10am; the first time in over 2 years! Cards are available at the back of the church with our full programme of events for Lent.

SYNOD 21-23

Our synodal process begins on Thursday 3rd March for 4 consecutive weeks. The meetings will take place at 7pm in the church hall, where each week, we will focus on a different theme.
