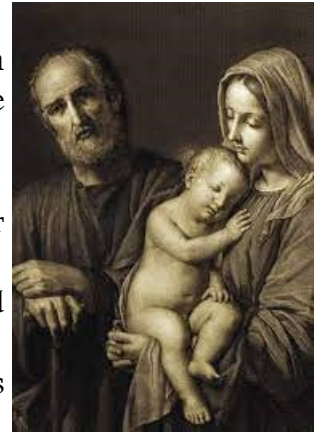

- Have a holy water font at the door to bless yourselves as you enter and leave your home.
- Bless each other before bedtime and pray for all your family members before you fall asleep.
- Consecrate your family to the Holy Family using the following prayer:-
