SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

On Thursday we celebrate the solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord into heaven. For 40 days after his resurrection on Easter Sunday, the Bible says that Jesus travelled and preached with his apostles, preparing them for his departure from Earth. Ascension Thursday marks the moment Jesus literally ascended into heaven before Mary and His disciples, at the village of Bethany, near Jerusalem. In the Eastern Church this feast was known as analepsis, "the taking up", and also as the episozomene, the salvation, denoting that by ascending into His glory, Christ completed the work of our redemption. The terms used in the West, ascensio and, occasionally, ascensa, signify that Christ was raised up by His own powers.

Acts provides the longest account of Christ's farewell to his disciples, bidding them to preach the word of God and assuring them of his eventual return for the Second Coming, the day of judgement in which the virtuous will be saved and the wrongdoers condemned.

"After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight," the book says.

"They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. 'Men of Galilee,' they said, 'why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven'."

The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord is a holyday of obligation. Mass times are as follows: Vigil (25th), 7pm, Thurs - 10am, 1pm and 7pm.
