

#### PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood.

### Promises of Jesus to those who honour His Precious Blood

To all those faithful who shall recite for three years, each day, 2 Our Fathers, 2 Hail Marys and 2 Glory bes in honour of the drops of blood I lost, I will concede the following five graces:

- 1. The plenary indulgence and remission of your sins.
- 2. You will be free from the pains of Purgatory.
- 3. If you should die before completing the said 3 years, for you it will be the same as if you had completed them.
- 4. It will be upon your death the same as if you had shed all your blood for the Holy Faith.
- 5. I will descend from Heaven to take your soul and that of your relatives, until the fourth generation.

### SPUC APPEAL ~ PUBLIC CONSULTAION ON BUFFER ZONES

The Society for the Protection of Unborn Children are asking as many people as possible to respond to this consultation which will run until Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2022. Brief details on the proposed Bill are given below and SPUC have produced a guide to filling out the consultation. We have a few copies of this guide at the back of the church which you are free to take away to help you fill out the consultation. As we have only a few copies please return them when you are finished so others can use them. The guide can also be found on SPUC's website (https://www.spuc.org.uk/scottishbufferzonesconsultation)

'A public consultation has been launched on a bill proposed by Gillian MacKay MSP to bring in buffer zones around facilities that provide abortions in Scotland. Ms MacKay's proposals would criminalise all pro-life activities in the vicinity of abortion facilities. If this Bill becomes law, anyone taking part in a pro-life vigil in Scotland would be subject to a 6 month jail sentence for a first offence, and up to 2 years in prison for subsequent breaches. It is vital that we have a large response from pro-lifers in Scotland. If this Bill becomes law, there are likely to be other measure to prohibit public pro-life witness and the display of pro-life material in public areas.'
