PILGRIMAGE TO ROME AND ASSISI

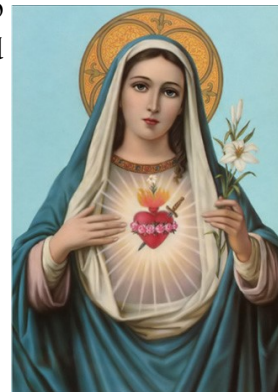

IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

The Catholic Church dedicates the month of August to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The Immaculate Heart is often venerated together with the Sacred Heart of Jesus (celebrated in June). Just as the Sacred Heart represents Christ's love for mankind, the Immaculate Heart represents the desire of the Blessed Virgin to bring all people to her Son. Jesus, her Son, wants to make her known and loved, with devotion established in the world to her Immaculate Heart. Our Lady mentioned her Immaculate Heart on many occasions, when she appeared to the children at Fatima. During the 2nd apparition, she told Lucia she would stay on the earth after her cousins went to heaven to establish devotion to her Immaculate Heart and she also told them that despite the wars, sufferings and persecutions of the Church, in the end, her Immaculate Heart will triumph.

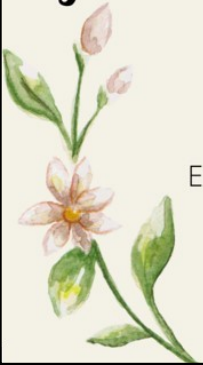
FR JOSHUA MOIR
