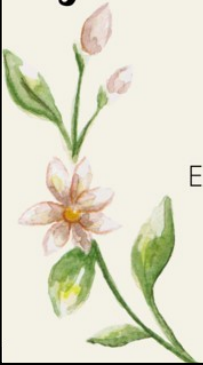
**FAITH SHARING GROUP**
