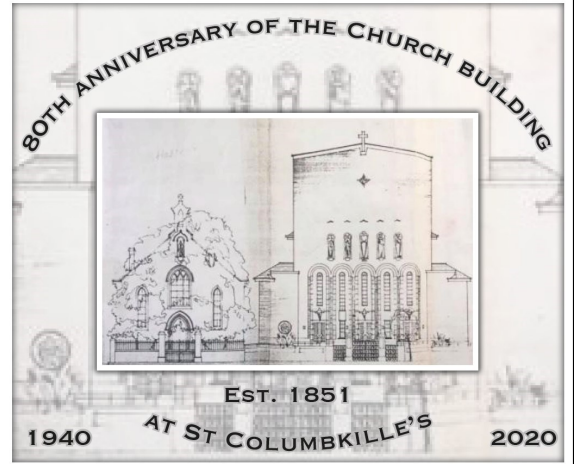

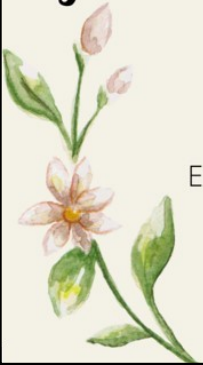
SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION
