- Transform their relationship with the Church that Christ founded.

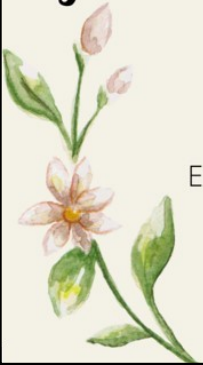
