READERS AND EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS

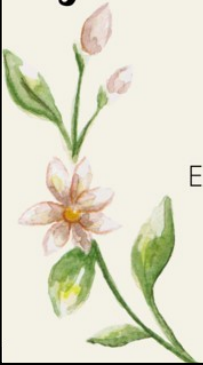
Dates for your diary:- Retreat mornings for our Readers and Eucharistic Ministers in March.
