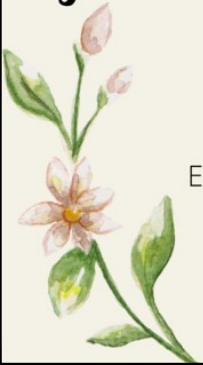
### **READERS AND EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS**
