EASTER TRIDUUM

Triduum comes from the Latin word meaning 'three days,' and encompasses the three most sacred days in our Church's year. It begins at sundown on Holy Thursday, reaches a high point at the Easter Vigil and concludes on Easter Sunday. The liturgies are one continuous celebration commemorating the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. **Catholics are encouraged to observe the entire Triduum by attending all of the liturgies.**

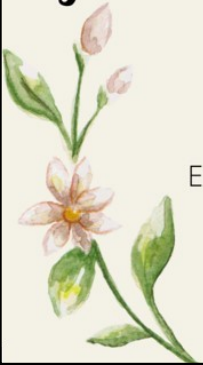
SPONSORED WALK 2023
