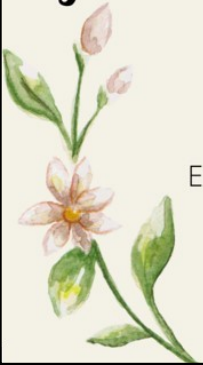
### **ROME PILGRIMAGE**
