

#### **GROUNDWORKS UPDATE**

We are delighted to announce that the building works will commence in the middle of July. Phase 1 of the project, concerning the refurbishment of the front of the church grounds is expected to take 13 weeks to complete, costs for this have been capped at £400,000. Details regarding access to the church while the building work is going on will be given in due course. Phase 2 which involves the refurbishment of the grounds to the side of the church will take place once Phase 1 is complete. In an effort to keep costs down we are hoping to be able to refurbish the access on this side using some of the paving slabs from the front of the church. This will also serve as a lovely way to preserve the memory of all those who have walked on these slabs when entering and leaving the church for over 80 years. Despite the monumental efforts of the whole parish there is still a shortfall in our funds. If anyone has any fundraising ideas to help us reach our final total we would very much appreciate your suggestions!


