Our 40 Hours Adoration will take place this year, on Sunday 11th June, the feast of Corpus Christi at 7am! It will conclude with 1pm Mass on Wednesday 14th June. A few items to draw your attention to are the Eucharistic Procession and Solemn Benediction which will take place after 12noon Mass on Sunday 11th June and the guided Holy Hours at 7pm on Monday 12th and Tuesday 13th June. The theme on Monday night is 'Mary, Mother of the Eucharist' and on Tuesday night is 'Emmaus: The Eucharist and the Pledge of Future Glory.' Confession will be available at the usual times and also on Monday 12th and Tuesday 13th June, 6-7pm.

All parishioners are strongly encouraged to participate in this wonderful opportunity to deepen and strengthen our faith by spending time with Our Blessed Lord in Eucharistic Adoration. Please tell family and friends, who are all most welcome to join us for what we pray will be a grace filled time in our parish.




