GROUNDWORKS PROJECT UPDATE

We are delighted to announce that our groundworks project has finally started! Please follow the designated routes to access the Church safely during the work. The second phase of the groundworks for the side of the church can now go ahead at the same time as the work at the front, thanks to the generosity of an individual donor. The contractors plan to reuse many of the existing flagstones that are currently in place. These will be reconditioned and re-laid. It is also important to recognise the historic value of these pavers that have been walked upon by generations of parishioners. We are extremely grateful to the individual benefactor for this substantial donation.

The total cost of the project is set at around £400,000. This figure incorporates some of the VAT. There will be more VAT to be added, however we cannot give a definite figure at this stage as a good proportion of the cost will be VAT exempt due to the nature of the disabled access and the Grade 1 Listed status of the Church building.

The Steering Group and the Parish Finance Committee would like to thank you all most sincerely for your continued support and generosity and we all look forward to seeing the completed project. Thank you once again for what has been such a team effort from the whole parish.


PARISH BOOK CLUB


