WELCOME MINISTRY - STEWARDS REQUIRED

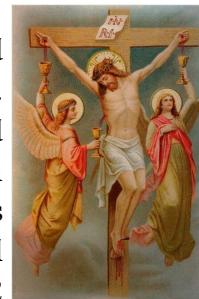
If you are interested in joining our welcome ministry as a steward, please speak to one of the clergy or ask at the office. Thank you to all our existing stewards for the wonderful job they do.

The 1st Tuesday Club returns on 1st August, 1.30 -3.30pm, we are a support group for those living with dementia and their carers. Everyone is made welcome.

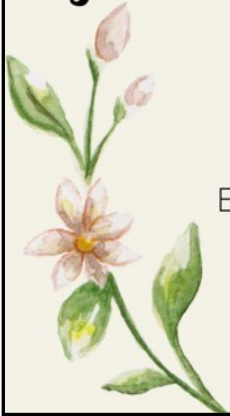
SVDP FOODBANK
