#### ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> August is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is a Holy Day of Obligation, Mass times for this feast day are given on the front of the bulletin.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is one of the four Marian dogmas of the Catholic Church. Pope Pius XII defined it on 1 November 1950 in his apostolic constitution Munificentissimus Deus as follows:

We proclaim and define it to be a dogma revealed by God that the immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven.




