

# CALL TO ACTION ~ ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL

The bill, which will allow assisted suicide for those who are terminally ill, mentally competent and who wish to die, will be debated and scrutinised by the Scottish Parliament and will eventually be voted on by MSPs in a free vote. #### FOOTBALL MEMORIES




