SPUC CAMPAIGN - END DIY ABORTION

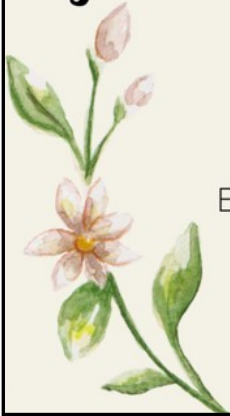
