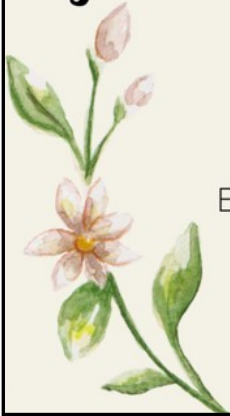
HOLY SOLES DAY OUT
