

Triduum comes from the Latin word meaning 'three days,' and encompasses the three most sacred days in our Church's year. It begins at sundown on Holy Thursday, reaches a high point at the Easter Vigil and concludes on Easter Sunday. The liturgies are one continuous celebration commemorating the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. Catholics are encouraged to observe the entire Triduum by attending all of the liturgies.
