CALLED TO CARE NOT TO KILL

Liam McArthur MSP has published a bill to legalise assisted suicide in Scotland which will be debated and scrutinised by the Scottish Parliament. In response the Bishops' Conference of Scotland have written a pastoral letter urging the Catholic community to contact their MSPs, to ask them to work collaboratively to improve palliative care, and to reject the dangerous proposal to legalise assisted suicide, which would devalue life and put immense pressure on the most vulnerable to end their lives prematurely. 
