

EASTER TRIDUUM

Triduum comes from the Latin word meaning 'three days,' and encompasses the three most sacred days in the Church's year. It begins at sundown on Holy Thursday, reaches a high point at the Easter Vigil and concludes on Easter Sunday. The liturgies are one continuous celebration commemorating the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. Catholics are encouraged to observe the entire Triduum by attending all of the liturgies.

Holy Week is the busiest week of the year in our parish; if you can spare any time to help prepare the church for the various liturgies please speak to Fr Mournian. Any help will be gratefully received!

ADORATION ~ HOLY TUESDAY
