PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ, a devotion that invites us to reflect on the profound mystery of Christ's sacrifice. The shedding of the Precious Blood is a manifestation of God's boundless love, the forgiveness of sins and the life-giving grace offered through the Holy Eucharist. It is a time to deepen our spiritual connection to this sacred mystery through prayer, penance and adoration.

Promises of Jesus to those who honour His Precious Blood

To those who recite daily for three years, 2 Our Fathers, 2 Hail Marys and 2 Glory bes in honour of the drops of blood I lost, I will concede five graces:

- 1. The plenary indulgence and remission of your sins.
- 2. You will be free from the pains of Purgatory.
- 3. If you should die before completing the said 3 years, for you it will be the same as if you had completed them.
- 4. It will be upon your death the same as if you had shed all your blood for the Holy Faith.
- 5. I will descend from Heaven to take your soul and that of your relatives, until the fourth generation.
