SILENCE AND REVERENCE IN CHURCH

My house shall be called a house of prayer...” (Matthew 21:13)

In our increasingly noisy world of today our churches should be places of silence, reverence and awe, a chance to step away from the external noise of our busy lives and to focus on Our Lord, fully present in the tabernacle. Our Lord often took himself away to a quiet place to pray with His Heavenly Father. If Jesus needed silence to speak to God, how much more do we need it? The General Instruction of the Roman Missal tells us that:-

‘Even before the celebration itself, it is commendable that silence be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred action in a devout and fitting manner.’

With this in mind could we ask that you:-

- Respectfully observe silence as much as possible in church,
- Make sure all mobile phones are switched off **BEFORE** entering church,
- If you have to speak to a steward please do this in the porch of the church,
- The stall door will remain unlocked but closed to reduce noise in the church and the stall will close 5 minutes before the start of Mass.
